### Whakataki / Introduction

Due to Covid concerns, the Hui a Tau (AGM) of Te Rūnanganui o ngā KKM has been postponed. Taranaki will retain the mauri of the hui a tau as they still want to host the AGM once the country returns to 'normal'.

As you will recall, the hui was due to be held March 18-19-20 with the kura closing on the 18<sup>th</sup> and 19.03.21. The kura will remain open on Thursday 18 March. Friday 19 March will be a teacher only day. All staff will be expected to attend along with any whānau who may have already intended to attend the Hui a Tau.

### Plan B

Plan B is to run a series of regional hui. Our rohe, Te Upoko (Manawatu, Wairarapa, Horowhenua, Ōtaki, Te Whanganui a Tara), will hui at TKKM o Te Rito, Otaki on Friday 19 March.

The two kura vans will depart Ngā Mokopuna at 8.30am in order to be in Ōtaki for the 9am pōhiri.

We have just learned the rohe of Te Matau a Māui (Hawke's Bay) will join us on the day. There are five other kura in our rohe, TKKM o Wairarapa, TKKM o Manawatu, TKKM o Mana Tamariki, TKKM o Te Rito and TKKM o Tamakinuiarua. There are 12 kura in Te Matau a Māui. We can expect each kura to send between five to 10 reps to the regional hui.
