Given tonight's announcement from the government regarding the three community cases of Covid in Auckland, please consider the following.

- If any whānau have visited South Auckland or New Plymouth since Waitangi weekend please stay at home for the next 48 hours (2 days) and talk to your doctor or health professional as to whether you need to have a covid test.
- For the full list of places visited by the two whānau members from Auckland who went to Taranaki, refer to the Ministry of Health Covid website.
- Anyone who has been to any of those places in particular, is to stay at home until they have a) had a Covid test and b) returned a negative result.

In the meantime, it's business as usual. Kura is open, the vans are running and the daily health practises will be revisited. As always, whānau are free to make their own decision as to whether they send their tamariki to kura, but we encourage all tamariki to still attend until we hear otherwise.

As per usual, if any person is feeling ill or displaying cold-like symptoms please stay at home for at least 48 hours and ring your health professional for advice before returning your tamaiti to kura.
